n this night Christian commemorate the supper Jesus shared ith his disciples before his crucifixion, when Jesus washed the sciples' feet (John 13:1-17) and instituted the Sacrament of the ord's Supper (Matthew 26:26-29; Mark 14:22-25; Luke 22:13-); 1 Corinthians 11:23-25).

x traditional actions on this night are included in the following rvice. They are (1) confession and pardon; (2) proclamation of e Word, (3) Footwashing, (4) the Lord's Supper, (5) stripping of e church, and (6) Tenebrae. Of these, (1), (2) and (4) are essenil; [3], [5], and [6] are optional.

he ancient practice of stripping the Lord's table and sanctuary llowing communion is a vivid and dramatic way of showing the esolation and abandonment of the long night in Gethsemane and hat followed. The church remains bare until Easter, when the ocess is reversed. (<u>United Methodist Book of Worship p. 351</u>)
